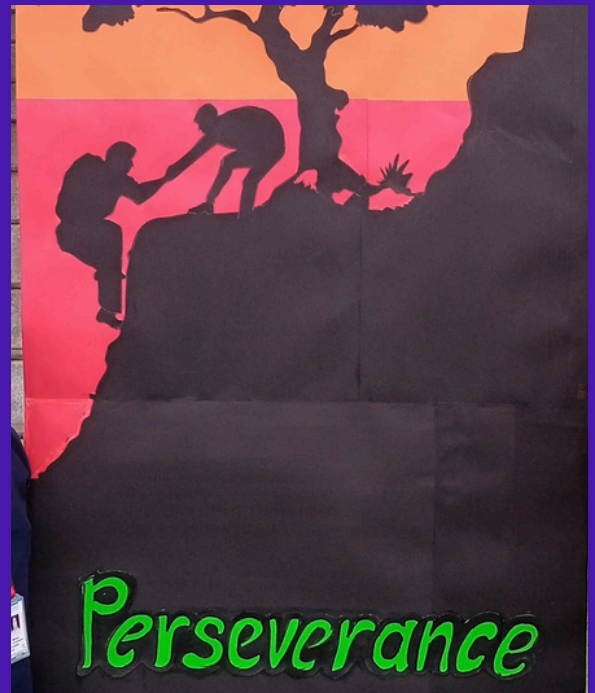
Empowering Change, Standing Up for the Downtrodden


SACRIFICE DAY

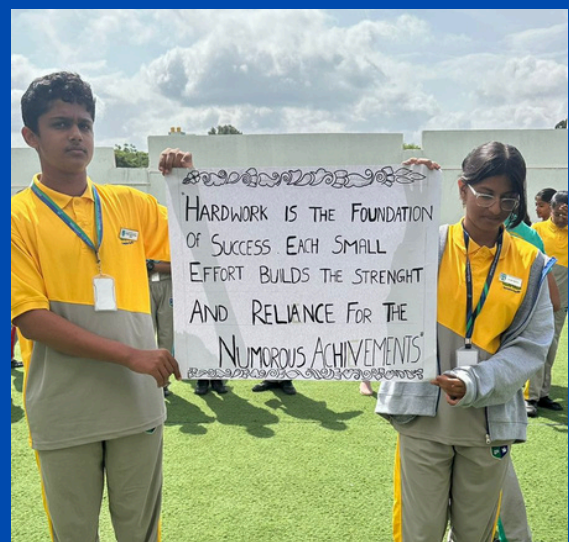


HARD WORK
